Eco- teams are encouraged to investigate different habitats and species, gathering inspiration from the internet to inform their artwork and to provide a deeper understanding of biodiversity and conservation. Participants are invited to choose from a diverse range of habit, including forests, jungles, grasslands, deserts, the arctic and oceans. This activity is designed to encourage entrants to explore the unique characteristics and biodiversity found within each environment.

When creating their A3 entry, eco- focused entrants can select from a wide array of art materials. Options will include mixed media, acrylic paints, oil pastels, and collage techniques. This flexibility will allow participants to express their creativity and interpretation of their chosen habitat using the materials that best suit their artistic vision.
