The Sustainability Learning Conference is scheduled for Thursday, 25th June at Blackburn Rovers.

This year, we are introducing a Trashion competition for high school students.

- This activity is designed to highlight the significance of reusing and recycling initiatives.
- The competition is open to all KS3 /4 students interested in demonstrating their design and creative skills.
- It can be approached as an individual, paired or group project.
- Some schools with textile departments, may wish to enter several garments
- As the designing and making will be done prior to the conference date, these students will be free to enter other team or individual events on the 25th of June
- Each garment designed and created for the Trashion competition will be presented in a dedicated catwalk event held in the afternoon. This showcase will be attended by KS2 pupils, providing an opportunity for younger students to view and appreciate the creativity and ingenuity demonstrated by the KS3 and KS4 participants.
- The winning entry will receive a cash prize of £50. In addition to this, the school represented by the winning student or team will be awarded a cheque for £100. These prizes are intended to recognise both individual creativity and the supportive role of the school in encouraging sustainable design initiatives.
- Other cash prizes of £25 could be awarded for highly commended entries.
